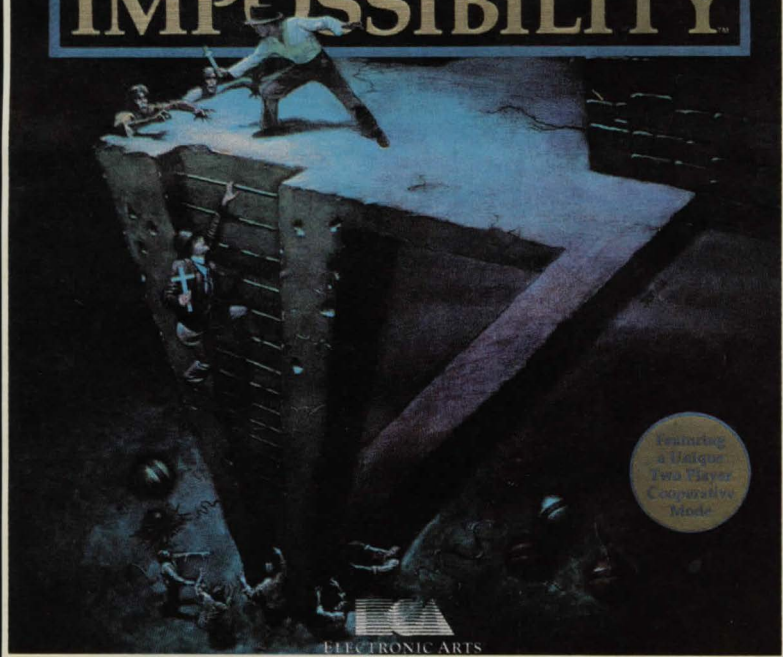

GETTING STARTED

Turn on the disk drive, turn on the computer and insert your disk in the drive. Type "EA", 8, 1 and press **Return**. When the program finishes loading, press the **space bar** to bring game instructions to the screen. Press it again each time you are ready to go to the next page of instructions. Press **f3** to return to the title screen.

GETTING STARTED**CASSETTE LOADING INSTRUCTIONS**

Insert cassette side one and rewind to beginning.
 Press shift and run/stop together.
 When found press space bar.
 When program finishes loading, press space bar to view instructions.
 Flip cassette to side two after choosing a dungeon.

PLAYING THE GAME

With the title screen displayed, press **f5** to choose between the one and two player games and **f3** to choose the level of difficulty. The bottom line on the screen will show the current settings. If it does not, press **f3** before using the **f5** and **f3** to set number of players and level.

Press **f7** or the **joystick button** to move to the "select a dungeon" screen. Use the joystick to move the arrow pointer to the dungeon you want and press the button to begin playing.

TO PAUSE AND RESUME OR START OVER

To freeze and "unfreeze" a game in progress, press **Run/Stop**. To stop a game so you can start a new one, press **f7**.
