For instance, under no circumstances should you buy this book at the same time you buy the Infocom story it's designed to accompany. We say that because the greatest pleasure to be gained from Infocom's interactive fiction is in solving the problems, puzzles, and mazes you encounter by means of your own ingenuity.

However, there are those times in the course of an Infocom story when even the most brilliant adventurer can really get stumped. That's where InvisiClues Hint Books come in handy.

Great care is taken to make sure that InvisiClues Hint Books will give you only the help you need, when you need it, and won't give away extraneous information unintentionally. To guard against this, Infocom words the questions to reveal as little as possible about the story, and uses the amazing InvisiClues process, which gives you invisible hints that usually progress from a gentle nudge in the right direction to a full answer. If you become stuck, all you have to do is find the question in your InvisiClues Hint Book that pertains to your problem, run your InvisiClues latent image marker (included in your InvisiClues kit) over the first answer, and—hey presto!—the answer appears before your very eyes.

There's a handsomely illustrated and easy-to-read hint book for each Infocom story, and scores of hints to choose from in every book. What's more, most InvisiClues books feature cleverlydrawn maps to help you with locations in the stories. (The exceptions are SUSPENDED<sup>™</sup> and SEASTALKER<sup>™</sup>, the maps for which are already included in the story packages.) By the way, special caution should be exerted with regard to the maps. If used too early in the course of your travels, they'll definitely give away too much.

And now, if you're ready, welcome to your InvisiClues Hint Book. The answer to your hairiest conundrum awaits you on Page—ah! but to say more would be telling secrets.
