Installation of *Infocom Masterpieces* is a two step process: 1) installation of the Infocom games and 2) installation of Adobe Acrobat Reader.

BEFORE INSTALLING

- We do not recommend installing this program to a compressed drive. If possible, install to a non-compressed drive.

HOW TO INSTALL

1. Insert the **Infocom Masterpieces** CD disc in the CD-ROM drive.
2. Select the **Start** button from the menu bar.
3. Click on **Run**. When the dialog box appears, click the **Browse** button. Use **Look in:** to find the CD-ROM drive with the Masterpieces CD disc.
4. Double-click on the **Masterpieces CD** disc icon.
5. Double-click on the **Winsetup** icon.
6. Follow the on-screen instructions. Once the Infocom installer is finished it will automatically launch the Adobe Acrobat installer.

BEFORE INSTALLING

Here is some important information that you should know before you install and start playing *Infocom Masterpieces for MS-DOS*.

HARD DISK

The game requires at least 40 MB of uncompressed free hard disk space. *Infocom Masterpieces* will not work properly using compressed hard disk space (such as Stacker and DoubleSpace).

HOW TO INSTALL

1. Insert **Infocom Masterpieces** into your CD-ROM drive (for these instructions, we will assume that your CD drive is drive D:).
2. At the DOS prompt, type **D:** and press **Enter**.
3. At the D:\> prompt, type **DOSSETUP** and press **Enter**.
4. Follow the on-screen instructions carefully.

MS-DOS TROUBLESHOOTING

MEMORY

Infocom Masterpieces requires a minimum of 640K of system memory (RAM). On some machines, even if you have the required 640K, *Infocom Masterpieces* may report that you do not have enough free extended or conventional memory.

You might try disabling SMARTDRV, changing your CONFIG.SYS and AUTOEXEC.BAT so that some of your drivers are loaded into conventional rather than high memory or setting your EMM386 line to NOEMS.

Since these modifications affect your CONFIG.SYS and AUTOEXEC.BAT files, you should consider making these changes to CONFIG.SYS and AUTOEXEC.BAT files on a boot disk.

The simplest way to do this is to open the **Extensions Manager** in the Control Panel and un-check all unnecessary extensions that you may be running. Then restart your computer.

2. Insert **Infocom Masterpieces CD** disc into your CD-ROM drive and wait a few moments until the Masterpieces CD-ROM icon appears. Double-click on the **Masterpieces** CD-ROM icon. Double-click on the **Acrobat Installer** icon.
3. Read the licensing agreement for Adobe Acrobat and click on **Accept**.
4. Follow the on-screen instructions.
5. When installation is complete, restart your Macintosh.

PROBLEM

The Infocom Masterpieces quits during installation

SOLUTION

Running System 6.0.7 MultiFinder. Change Start-up configuration to start up with Finder.


