UNDERGROUND testing helps us to develop more and better nuclear weapons.



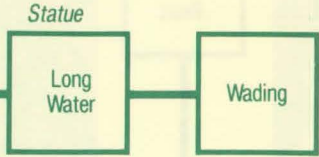
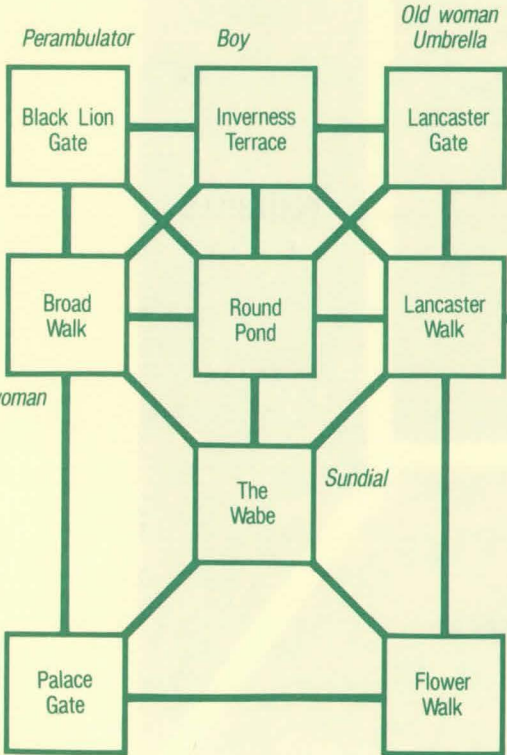

In the depths of OUTER SPACE, an orbiting "umbrella" of high technology defends the Free World from nuclear attacks.

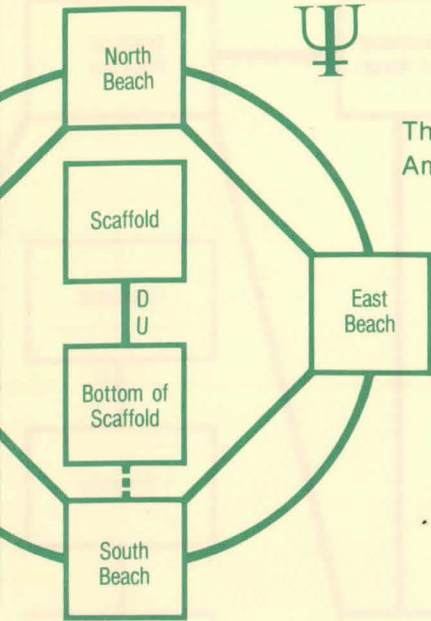


With advanced defense systems now in place, lovely parks like London's KENSINGTON GARDENS are safe from the threat of atomic war.

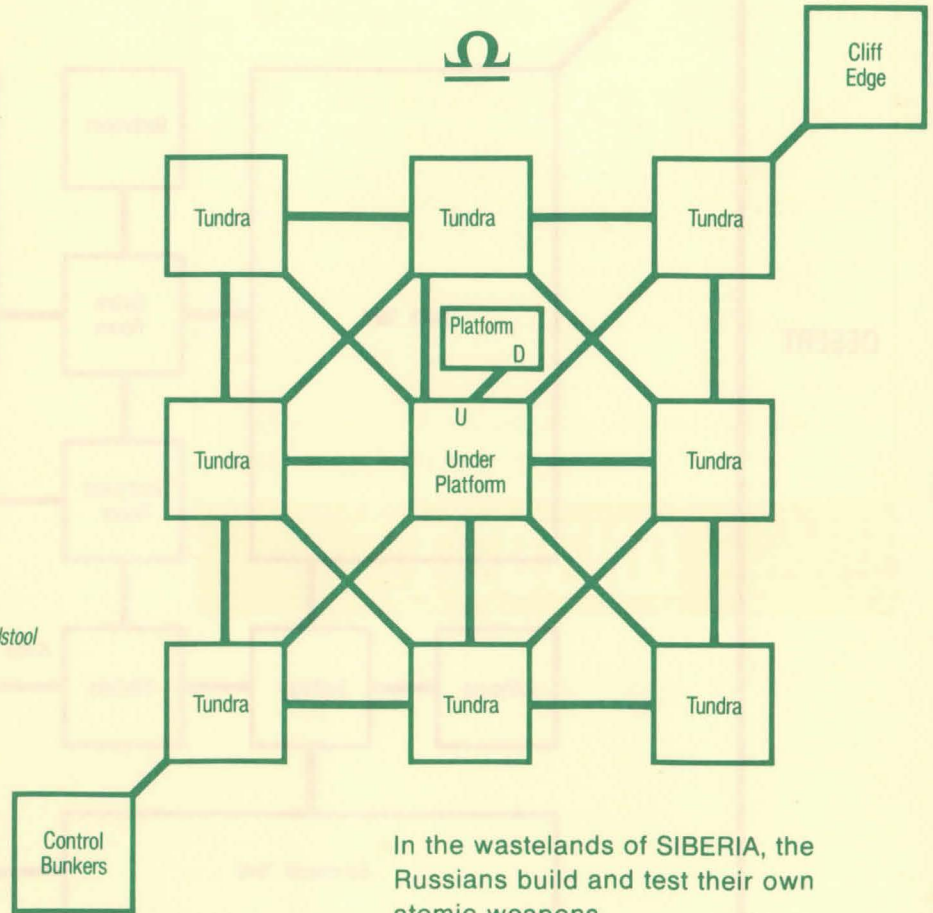




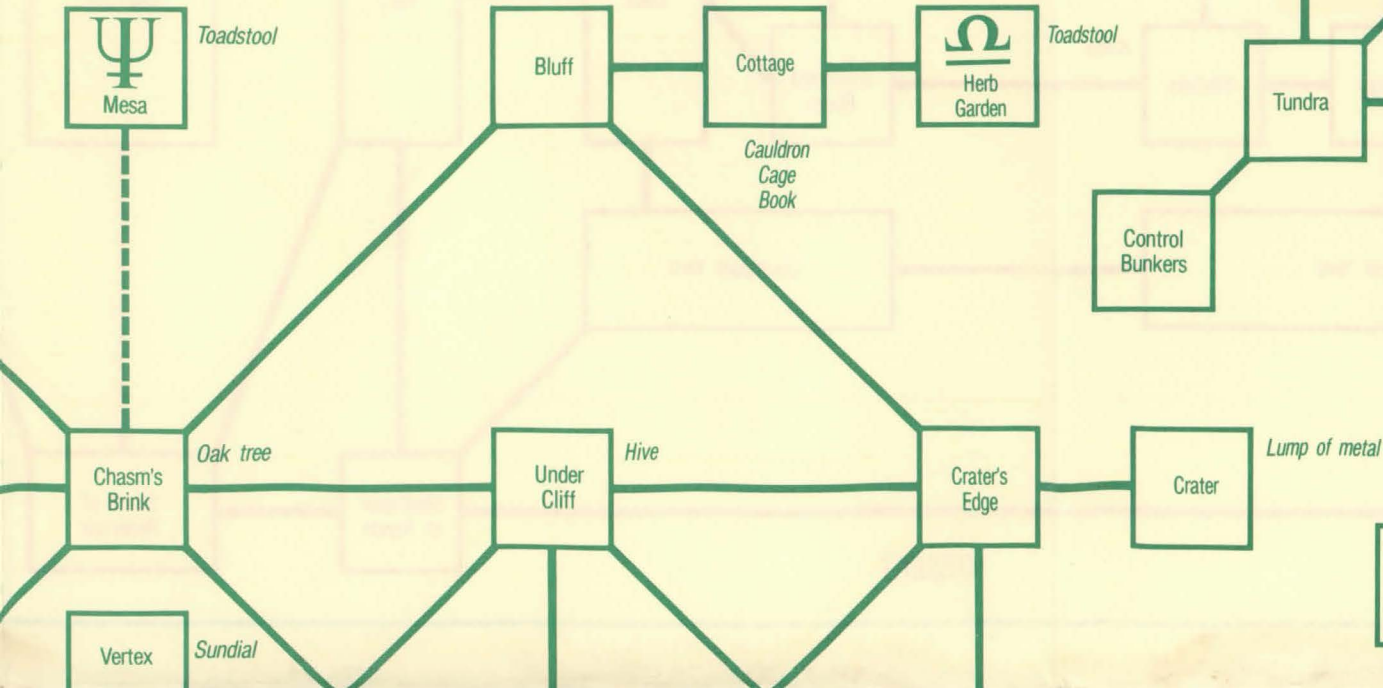
The Eniwetok ATOLL was the site of America's first H-bomb explosion.



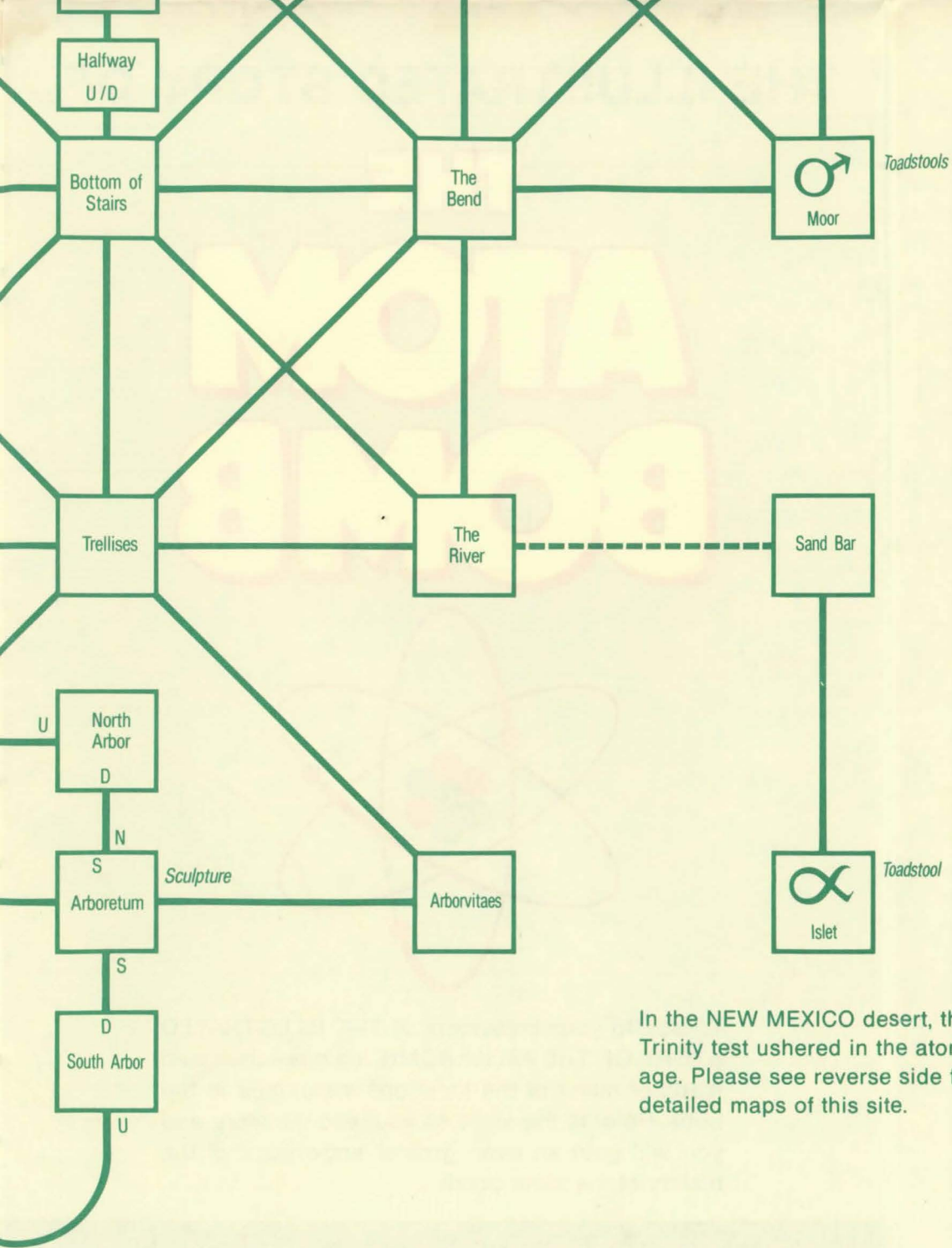

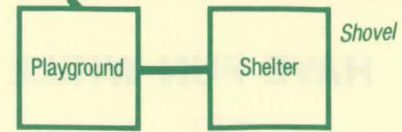
In the wastelands of SIBERIA, the Russians build and test their own atomic weapons.

MERCURY - swift messenger of the Roman Gods

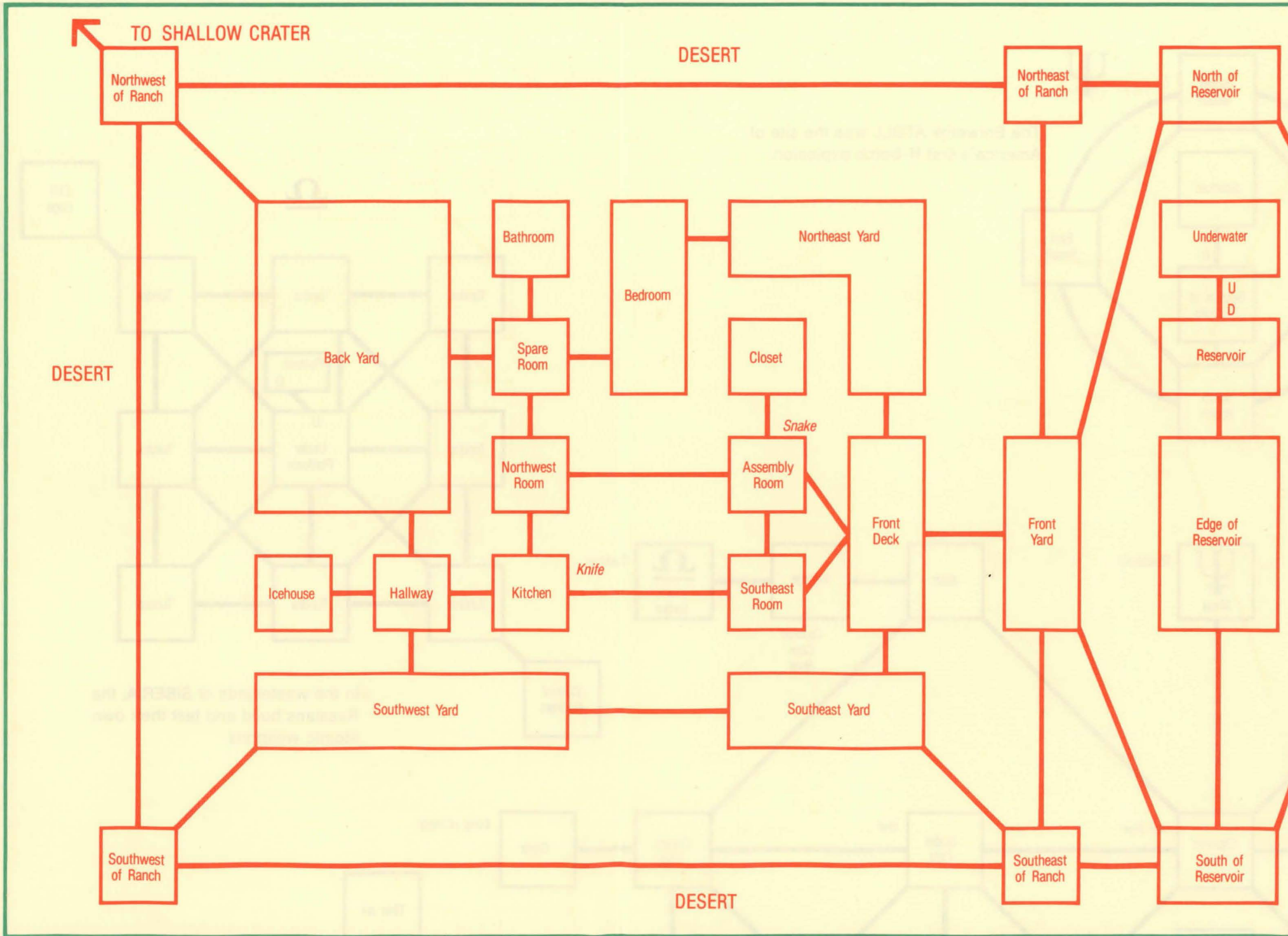
PLUTO - Greek God of the Underworld

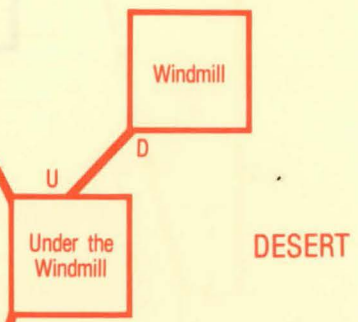
LIBRA - constellation of the Balance

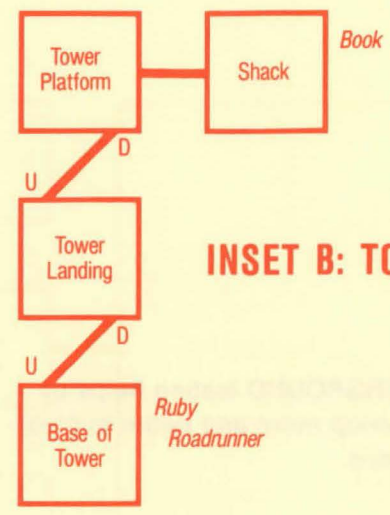

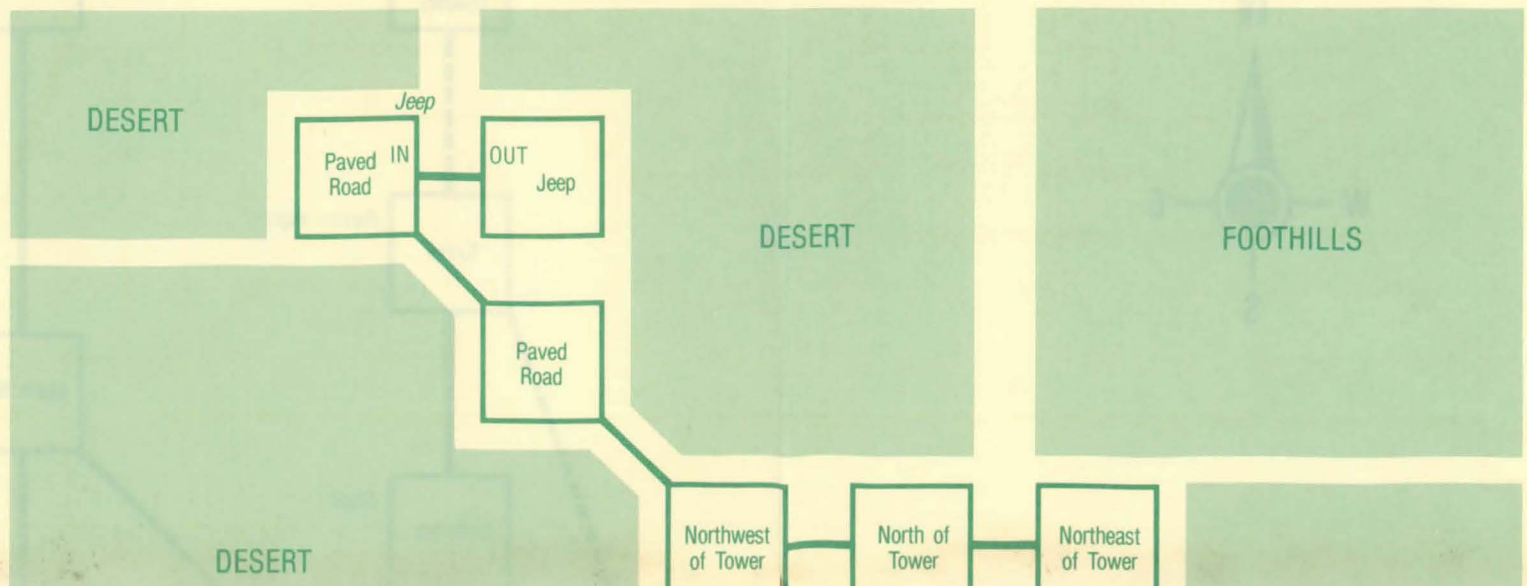
## INSET A: RANCH AREA

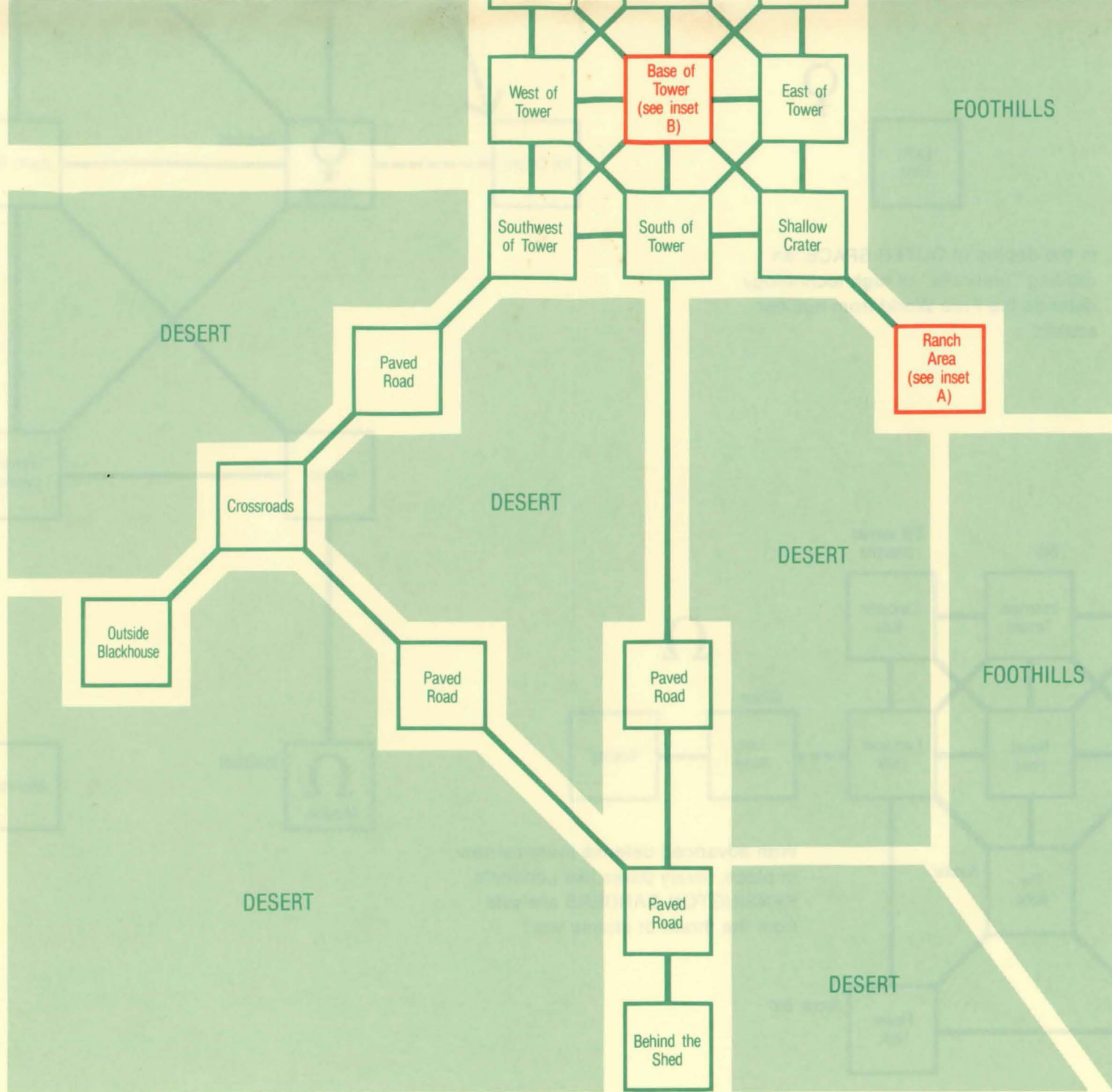

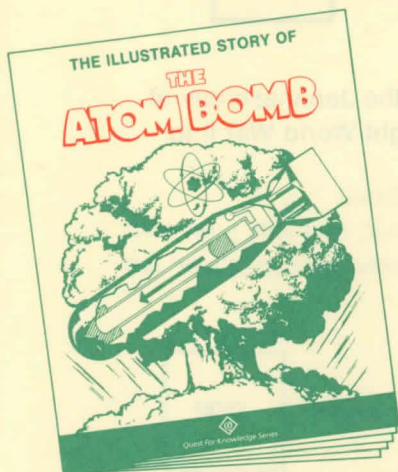
