Dwarves have high strength and constitution in addition to their power to know how far above or below ground they are. Halfings hurl objects with amazing accuracy.

One module - Seekers of the Storm. Quite simply, it's the finest role-playing adventure ever created for a microcomputer. It requires an equal share of hack 'n slay and puzzle solving to reach its climactic conclusion. In other words, a minimum of 30 hours.

★ Twelve plots - When (or if) you finish the module, the computer can generate an infinite variety of castles to suit 12 unique "plots." Each plot takes about 10-15 hours to solve.

Lots of stuff - Over 50 weapons. Over 100 spells. 10 martial arts modes. 3 haggling merchants. Over 20 types of armor. Over 200 monsters. Gems. Jewels. Furniture. Money. Brooches. Barrels. And on it goes and goes and goes...
