RUNNING THE MICRO STAR DISKETTES

- 1. First, boot up your system. If you have a floppy drive system, insert your DOS system diskette in drive A and turn on the computer. If you have a hard drive system, simply turn on the computer. The computer will go through its system checks and after a few moments you will be presented with the DOS prompt (depending on your computer setup, this will be either A> or C>.)
- 2. After making backups of your Micro Star diskettes, insert your *copy* of the original Micro Star disk in drive A. If there are multiple disks in your package, start with disk #1.
- 3. Make sure you are at the A> prompt. To do this, type $\bf A$: and then hit the <ENTER> key.
- 4. Before doing anything else, check the label on the Micro Star original for a startup command. Under most circumstances, this command will be **MS**, but at times may be different.
- 5. To run the command, type in the command at the DOS prompt and then press the <ENTER> key. Running MS will present you with either a menu or an instruction screen. To use the menu, press the letter in the angle brackets (<>) to run that function. If you aren't presented with a menu, simply follow the instructions on the screen to get started.
- 6. We highly recommend that you read through the program documentation (if any) before running an application.
