

Atari ST-Quick Reference Card

Hard Drive Installation:

Installing Disciples of Steel on your Hard Drive is relatively simple. Create a folder on one of your Drive partitions naming whatever you wish. (This partition must have at least 1.6 MB of free space.) Proceed to copy all files from your original Disciples of Steel disks into the folder you just created upon your Hard Drive ignoring any duplicate files. Now you're ready to go!

Interfacing Disciples of Steel:

Most pop-up menus within the game can be called using the right mouse button, the space bar, or the '0' on the numeric pad.

Cancellation of menus and many functions throughout the game can be done with a press of the 'Escape' key.

Keyboard Equivalents:

- Dungeon: P - Select Disciple to take the **Point**
 S - **Search** the party's current location for treasure
- World : M - Brings for a **Map** of Lanathor
- Combat : W - **Wait** for another opportunity at the end of turn
 T - **Take** treasure
 P - Select Disciple's attack location
 A - End turn **Aiming**
 S - **Search** for Hidden foes
 F - **Fire** ranged weapon
 G - End turn on Defensive **Guard**
 H - Attempt to **Hide**
 L - Manual **Look** about the battle field
 Z - Reselect Disciple facing

Moving into Foe initiates an attack with currently Readied Weapon.

Atari ST-Quick Reference Card

General Icons on Bottom Left of Screen:

- V - View current Disciple
- B - Look at the contents of current Disciple's **Backpack**
- X - Apply accumulated experience
- C - **Cast** a spell
- I - View Disciple's Injuries

Health Menu:

Graphical View of Damage - Mouse left click in upper right text screen calls Graphical Display of Injuries.

Skills Menu:

- + / - Cycles through available Skills

Character Selection Menu:

Tab - Calls this Menu within Character Display
Information as well as a mouse left click in the uppermost right hand corner of the screen.

- P - Pool Gold to current Disciple
- 1- 8 - Select Disciple
- Escape Key - Cancel
- Return - Select Highlighted Disciple

Multi-Item Selector:

- + / - Auto Select/DeSelect Items
- S - Select Item
- D / Return - Selection completed

We recommend that users experiment with the menus, as a great many screen objects are of the point and click variety.

Programmer's Notes:

A great effort has been made to insure that this product is fully compatible with the Atari ST/STe/TT line of computers.

Obviously, in a game of this size, memory is of paramount importance. On an Atari ST with 1 MegaByte of memory, a minimum of 800K must be available for DOS to run. Disciples of Steel dynamically allocates memory for maximum game performance, thus the more memory made available to DOS the better.
