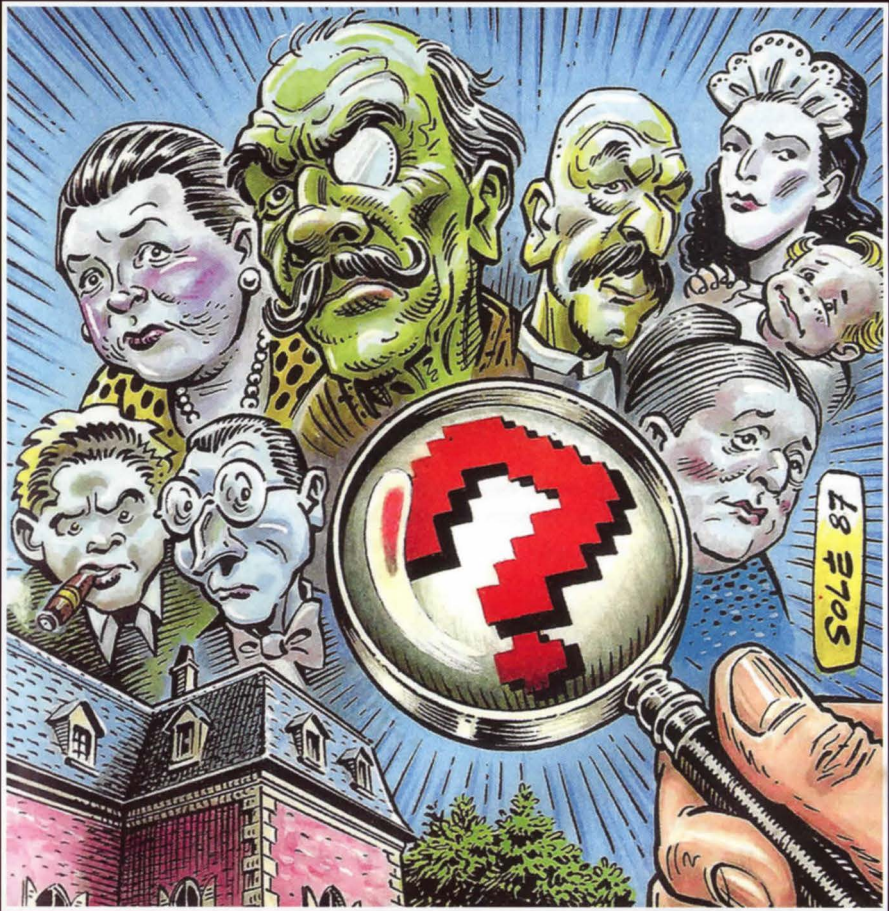

Theme of the game

Of course you accept and you are on the way to the manor of La Fêlure to elucidate the mystery of the disappearance of the Count...

Manual

Insert your disk and switch on your Apple II.

The GAMES

You can choose between four options: start an investigation (new, restart), resume a previous investigation (load), save the current investigation (save) or leave the game (quit).

The FACILITIES

By typing «score» at any point in the game, you will see the status of your progress. Obviously, the investigation is completely and perfectly solved only when this curve reaches the 100% level!

By typing «text» or «image», the game will only display in text mode or with images. «help» will tell you a few words from the dictionary.

How to play?

- You can move by typing: north, south, east, west, up, down.

- You can type an option, see FACILITIES.

- You can conduct your investigation by typing phrases on the keyboard. No more than 100 characters per sentence. Long sentences require a little longer analysis time. If the computer does not understand, try to vary your vocabulary.

Some examples, in the first room you can say:

- enter

- enter this beautiful mansion

- open the door.

- break a glass

etc.

Note: At the beginning of your investigation, most rooms are empty. As you progress, different characters will appear.

Total depression

You have been going round in circles for days without finding a single clue for your investigation. Depression and paranoia are waiting for you. Doctor Froggy can cure you. To obtain the solution of the game, write to docteurfroggy@brutaldeluxe.fr.

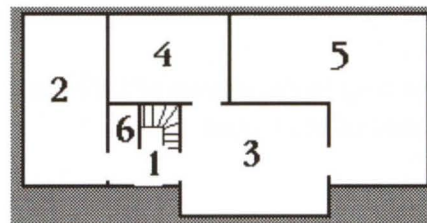

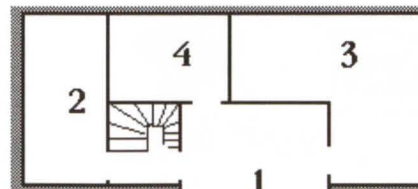
